

Glycerol G, UCO-based

Product description

Glycerol is produced as co-product in the production of biodiesel. Biodiesel is generally produced from rapeseed oil, but sunflower and soya oil can be used as well. In this case, Used Cooking Oil (UCO) is used. The raw oil is refined and then converted into biodiesel and glycerol through a process of esterification. The glycerol content amounts to around 10% and is used e.g. in the production of biogas.
